Link to file download A man has died in hospital after an attack on a train platform at Manchester Victoria. He was rushed to hospital in an ambulance shortly before 2pm on Wednesday. His injuries are not thought to be life-threatening and detectives are investigating. A Metropolitan Police spokesperson said: "Police were called at around 1.59pm this afternoon to reports of a serious assault on the platform of the Victoria line. "Officers attended and a man was taken to hospital by ambulance. His injuries are not thought to be life-threatening. "An area of Victoria has been cordoned off for a forensic examination.

Detectives are investigating." This is an incident to update. A man has died in hospital following an assault at Manchester Victoria train station. Police are investigating. — Metropolitan Police (@metpoliceuk) February 11, 2019 Witnesses said the attacker was "waving a sword around", having been "dismissed" by security staff. "The security guard walked off, looked down the platform and walked back over, and the guy was waving a sword around," said one. "It was an old guy on his own, dressed in a top hat and jacket with a sword. "He had it on a black hilt."
